

## **Industrial Hygienist**

### **Position Summary**

The Industrial Hygienist position requires the individual to be detail oriented, organized, personable and dependable.

#### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Conduct building inspections to identify hazardous materials such as asbestos, lead-based paint, and other regulated materials.
- Conduct indoor air quality (IAQ) assessments, water intrusion and mold assessments, smoke contaminant assessments, and other industrial hygiene/environmental projects.
- On-site asbestos, and lead-based paint remediation oversight.
- Conduct site reconnaissance including sampling activities, if necessary.
- Field equipment operation.
- Preparation of field documents (notes, forms, photographs, figures, logs).
- · Report preparation and editing.
- Communicate project schedules, findings, and recommendations to staff and senior consultants.
- Local travel of 50% is expected; nationwide travel is possible and 2nd/3rd shift or weekend work may be required.

#### **Minimal Qualifications**

- BA/BS in Industrial Hygiene, Environmental and Occupational Health, Environmental Science, or another related STEM field (Chemistry, Biology, Life Sciences).
- 0-3 years of experience with asbestos inspections or another related industrial hygiene practice area;
  with preferred added experience in environmental sciences, mold, lead, field sampling, and data collection; and the ability to calibrate/operate sampling equipment.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office, particularly Excel and Word and related software; drafting reports; and understanding and interpreting construction documents, laboratory data, and regulations.
- Current Gulf Coast State Lead-Based Paint Risk Assessor License, Asbestos Project Manager License, Asbestos Inspector License, and NIOSH 582 Microscopy Training are preferred.
- Applicable Mold, Asbestos, Lead, and Air Sampling certification/licenses are preferred.
- Professional Licenses/Certifications Preferred: OSHA 40-hour HAZWOPER.
- A valid driver's license and personal vehicle are also required.
- Medical approval by the Company's appointed physician, after employment is accepted, prior to the first day of work.
- The ideal candidate is a self-motivated individual with superior communications skills who excels in a team environment.



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## **Physical Requirements**

- Able to lift a minimum of 40 pounds.
- Perform sedentary work requiring exerting up to 10 pounds of force occasionally.
- Visual acuity.
- Hearing and talking to perceive the expression and exchange of ideas.
- Walk and climb over rough terrain.
- Perform moderate physical tasks.
- Work in inclement weather conditions and temperature extremes.
- Work around potential hazardous or noxious materials and be able and willing to don personal protective equipment.
