### **Position Summary**

The Phase I ESA & NEPA Consultant position seeks a candidate who is detail-oriented, organized, personable, and dependable.

#### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Conduct Phase I Environmental Site Assessments (ESA) and prepare comprehensive Phase I ESA
  reports. This includes conducting environmental database searches, historical record reviews,
  stakeholder interviews and site reconnaissance activities.
- Clearly communicate the findings of Phase I ESAs and recommend further investigation or action, as needed. Collaborate with senior staff to develop scopes of work and proposals for additional investigative activities.
- Prepare environmental due diligence reports in compliance with the Small Business Administration (SBA), United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), Illinois Department of Military Affairs (IDMA), etc.
- Support the preparation of National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documents such as Categorical Exclusions (CATEx) and Environmental Assessments (EA) for projects using federal funds.
- Perform screening of listed and/or proposed threatened or endangered species, critical habitat, National Wetland Inventory Maps (NWI), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM), etc., as well as correspondence with Tribal, federal, state, and local agencies.
- Consultation and communication with regulatory agencies including but not limited to State Historic Preservation Office, Tribal Offices, Fish and Wildlife Service, Natural Resources Conservation Service, Army Corp. of Engineers, and various State environmental regulatory agencies.
- Knowledge of relevant environmental laws and regulations impacting Phase I ESAs and NEPA
  projects including, but not limited to, the Resource Conservation Recovery Act, Comprehensive
  Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, Endangered Species Act, Clean Water
  Act, Clean Air Act, National Historic Preservation Act, Farmland Protection Policy Act, etc.
- Must be a self-starter, resourceful, and have the ability to work productively on multiple projects at a time under strict deadlines with guidance from senior staff.
- Collaborate with co-workers in other areas of environmental due diligence to complete projects.
- Travel may be required within Wisconsin and Illinois, with occasional out-of-state trips. This position can be based out of the Madison, Wisconsin or the Naperville, Illinois office.
- 2nd/3rd shift, overnight stays, and/or weekend work may be required.

#### **Minimal Qualifications**

- Applicants should have a BA/BS in a Science Related Discipline.
- A minimum of 1-3 years of experience performing Phase I ESAs, NEPA evaluations or other environmental due diligence assessments.
